


#### INDONESIAN WHEAT FLOUR INDUSTRY 1970-1998: 5 flour mills & 2016: 31 flour mills



## INDONESIAN WHEAT FLOUR CONSUMPTION




## INDONESIAN WHEAT FLOUR CONSUMPTION PERIOD: 2005- 2015 (In MMT)






## INDONESIAN WHEAT FLOUR CONSUMPTION PERIOD: 2005- 2015 (Growth, in %)






## INDONESIAN WHEAT GRAIN IMPORTS (2015 vs 2014) (Total Import 2015: 7.41 MMT)

## INDONESIAN PERSPECTIVE OF AUSTRALIAN WHEAT GRAIN

#### **In General**:

1. The quality of Australian wheat is <u>relatively</u> <u>consistent</u> in the one harvest period.

#### 2. Australian Wheat:

- good wheat quality (bright noodle color, consistent dough characteristic)
- good milling property (good flour extraction, less foreign matters, low wheat moisture)



#### INDONESIAN PERSPECTIVE OF AUSTRALIAN WHEAT GRAIN

#### 3. Services:

Very good services from Australian Government & traders. No quarantine and customs issues. We feel confident in the Australia – Indonesia quarantine recognition



## INDONESIAN PERSPECTIVE OF AUSTRALIAN WHEAT GRAIN

#### 2015/2016 Crop year:

- 1. Lower gluten
- 2. A bit higher foreign matters/screenings
- 3. Relatively expensive

#### **Expectation:**

- 1. Availability of APH13 & AH13
- 2. Development of high protein wheat for bread



#### **CONCLUSION:**

- 1. Flour Mills Industry grows since the 1998:
  - 1970 1998 (Bulog Era) : 5 Flour Mills
  - in 2015 (post deregulation) : 31 Flour Mills (centralized in Java, 26 flour mills)
  - Total Wheat Milling Capacity : 11.4 Million MT
- 2. Percapita consumption: 22.2 kg/cap/year (Wheat eq. 29.3 kg/cap/year)
- 3. In general, The quality of Australian wheat is relatively consistent in the one harvest period.
- 4. Australian Wheat: good wheat quality (bright noodle color, consistent dough characteristic); good milling property (good flour extraction, less foreign matters, low wheat moisture)
